- Must pass post-offer background screening. Due to insurance contract requirements, candidates with felony convictions will not be considered. Any other convictions will need to be discussed with Human Resource Director for contract compliance.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Perform disaster response, emergency mitigation, water extraction, structural drying, and demolition to include removal of drywall, flooring, insulation, etc., following IICRC standards.
- Set up drying equipment at the work site, ensuring proper set up and removal.
- Moving of contents / furniture to assess mitigation areas.
- Perform moisture mapping and loss documentation.
- Participate in our 24-hour on call rotation, responding to emergency losses after hours and on weekends, as dictated by the on-call schedule. Overtime for this position is required, but is not guaranteed.
- Drive company vehicles, including water trucks and trailers (does not require CDL)
